John J. Daly, Jr. currently serves as the Director of Corporate Operations at the Naval Air Warfare Center, Training Systems Division (NAWCTSD) in Orlando, Florida. NAWCTSD is the U.S. Navy center for research, development, test and evaluation, and acquisition of training systems for the warfighter, focusing on innovative modeling, gaming and simulation technology solutions. Mr. Daly joined the NAWCTSD team after serving six years as a member of the Transportation Security Executive Service at DHS/TSA. While with DHS/TSA, Mr. Daly served as a Federal Security Director at some of the largest, most complex airports in the nation, including Orlando International Airport, Miami International Airport and John F. Kennedy International Airport. As Regional Director in the Office of Security Operations in Atlanta, he oversaw domestic transportation security operations in eight states and two territories in the southeast United States. This included direct supervision of 24 field executives and more than 11,000 DHS/TSA employees at 72 airports. He also served in the Office of Global Strategies overseeing DHS/TSA international engagement with all nations in the Western Hemisphere.

Before joining DHS/TSA, Mr. Daly served as a Director on the Homeland Security Council staff at the White House for two Presidential administrations. In this capacity, he was directly responsible for coordinating the development and implementation of national-level policies relating to cargo, port, maritime, and supply chain security, in addition to leading interagency collaboration with Mexico and Canada on infrastructure and security improvements at our land ports-of-entry. A retired officer from the U.S. Coast Guard, Mr. Daly spent most of his 24-year military career in the field conducting law enforcement, search and rescue, and national defense operations in the Western Hemisphere, and in the North Arabian Gulf in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom. Mr. Daly also served two years as the Military Aide to the President, where he was responsible for ensuring the nation's strategic defense capability, and served as the Special Assistant to the Under Secretary for Management at DHS during the largest reorganization of government since 1947, bringing 22 agencies together under one department.

Mr. Daly earned a Bachelor of Science degree from the U.S. Coast Guard Academy; a Master of Business Administration from the College of William & Mary; and a Master of Arts in National Security and Strategic Studies from the Naval War College. He is an Associate Faculty member at Valencia College and has actively served as part of the Combined Federal Campaign LFCC Board in Central Florida and other locations since 2009.
