He has commanded and led Soldiers, Sailors, Airmen, and Marines from over 50 nations during operations in *Operation Inherent Resolve*, *Operation Enduring Freedom* and *Operation Iraqi Freedom*, among others.

James has received numerous U.S. Military awards and decorations including the Defense Distinguished Service Medal, the Distinguished Service Medal and the Legion of Merit. Additionally, he was awarded the Canadian Meritorious Service medal by the Canadian Governor General for support of Canadian forces in Afghanistan.
